As a fresh, independent band, Family Junction is unconformed to conventional industry standards and believes that stage performances and content production should be evolutionary and constantly challenge the standard. From this idea brewed Family Junction's second album release, *Running Trains* (we're huge in Japan), a double-disc adventure, which is set to bring them into a world of their own.

The self-produced CD portion of *Running Trains* contains thirteen tightly crafted, complexly arranged songs. Family Junction members Alan Cohen (guitar/bass/vocals), Dan Levine (guitar/vocals), Ryan Pressman (guitar/bass/drums), and Matt Ross (guitar/bass/drums) switch and re-switch instruments, enabling the band to independently capture various styles of music, from progressive to funk, from jazz to rock, and from folk to hip hop.

The DVD portion of *Running Trains* contains a day-in-the-life-alternative-universe-musical-adventure of rejected superheroes as they interact with the world around them. The after-school-special-length (40min) movie, which was written, filmed and directed entirely by the band, provides an interactive experience for viewers with special features that include: an alternative version of the entire movie viewable by switching to the alternate angle at any point during the movie, commentary tracks by characters and creators, hidden Easter egg videos throughout the whole movie, a 3D scene viewable with traditional red and blue lensed glasses, and a 5.1 Dolby Digital surround sound mix.

Running Trains also comes with a twelve-song compilation album, *FamJam's Music-Stache*, Vol. 1, of independent/unsigned artists. The songs are already in mp3 format to be easily dragged into a digital music library to be freely shared and distributed. Liner notes for the *Music-Stache* are also included in data section.
